

Most older adults—and more than 61 million people with disabilities—live in non-institutional settings, relying on independent providers, agencies, and family members to care for them. Unfortunately, thousands of incidents involving the health and welfare of these individuals who receive Medicaid Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) go unreported, placing them at risk of illness, injury, or even death.

In fact, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' (CMS) proposed rule changes seek to establish nationwide standards requiring state Medicaid agencies to identify, report, triage, investigate, resolve, track, and trend critical incidents to ensure the health and welfare of HCBS waiver program recipients.
